### What are cookies on a website?

Cookies are small files, which a website may put on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website or application. Cookies help store preferences and other information on webpages that you visit.

<b>Functional cookies</b>	These cookies may be used to provide services you have asked for like for example watching a video (via YouTube).
<b>Performance cookies</b>	These cookies collect information about how visitors use our website. These cookies are used to help optimize our website and make them easier to navigate. These cookies do not include information that identify visitors. For embedded videos hosted on YouTube, generally cookies are used. These cookies may contain information that would allow YouTube to identify you as a user.
<b>Analytics and Research</b>	Websites use cookies to learn which of their services are most used. These cookies help determine what to improve, what to remove and what to leave unchanged.
<b>Advertising cookies</b>	Like many companies, we use Google Analytics on our website.
